**1. Waiver to Exclude Title I, Part A ARRA Funds in Determining an LEA's 20 Percent Obligation for Choice-Related Transportation and SES**

We are requesting a waiver for school year 2009-10 of the requirement to determine the LEA's "20 percent obligation" for public school choice-related transportation and supplemental educational services (SES) based on the LEA's total 2009-10 Title I, Part A allocation (*i.e.*, including both its regular and ARRA Title I, Part A allocations).

Specifically, we are seeking this waiver to exclude some or all of the Title I, Part A funds received under the ARRA in calculating the "20 percent obligation" for choice-related transportation and SES.

We hereby assure that if granted the requested waiver, we will comply with the following:

- o We will comply with all statutory and regulatory obligations for the provision of SES and public school choice with respect to our regular Title I, Part A allocation;
  - o We will use the funds freed up by the waiver to address needs identified based on data, such as Statewide or formative assessment results;
  - o We will comply with all other Title I, Part A statutory and regulatory obligations, including the obligations in sections 1114 and 1115 to have schoolwide and targeted assistance programs that "use effective methods and instructional strategies that are based on scientifically based research;" and
  - o In this application amendment, we will describe the data on which we relied to identify needs that will be addressed using the funds freed up by the waiver and the evidence that supports the strategies we intend to use to address those needs.

**2. Waiver to Exclude Title I, Part A ARRA Funds in Determining the 10 Percent Professional Development Set-Aside for an LEA in Improvement**

Specifically, we are seeking this waiver to exclude some or all of the Title I, Part A funds received under the ARRA in calculating the district-level 10 percent professional development set-aside.

We hereby assure that if granted the requested waiver, we will comply with the following:

- o We will comply with all statutory and regulatory obligations for the professional development set-aside with respect to our regular Title I, Part A allocation;
  - o We will use the funds freed up by the waiver to address needs identified based on data, such as Statewide or formative assessment results;
  - o We will comply with all other Title I, Part A statutory and regulatory obligations, including the obligations in sections 1114 and 1115 to have schoolwide and targeted assistance programs that "use effective methods and instructional strategies that are based on scientifically based research;" and
  - o In this application amendment, we will describe the data on which we relied to identify needs that will be addressed using the funds freed up by the waiver and the evidence that supports the strategies we intend to use to address those needs.

**3. Waiver to Exclude Title I, Part A ARRA Funds in Determining the 10 Percent Professional Development Set-Aside for a School in Improvement**

  - o We will use the funds freed up by the waiver to address needs identified based on data, such as Statewide or formative assessment results;
  - o We will comply with all other Title I, Part A statutory and regulatory obligations, including the obligations in sections 1114 and 1115 to have schoolwide and targeted assistance programs that "use effective methods and instructional strategies that are based on scientifically based research".

**4. Waiver to Exclude Title I, Part A ARRA Funds in Determining the Per-Pupil Amount for SES**

We are requesting a waiver for school year 2009-10 of the requirement to determine the per-pupil amount for supplemental educational services (SES) based on an LEA's total 2009-10 Title I, Part A allocation (*i.e.*, including both its regular and ARRA Title I, Part A allocations).

Specifically, we are seeking this waiver to exclude some or all of the Title I, Part A funds we receive under ARRA in calculating the per-pupil amount for SES.

We hereby assure that if granted the requested waiver, we will comply with the following:

- o We will comply with all statutory and regulatory obligations for the provision of SES with respect to our regular Title I, Part A allocation;
  - o We will comply with all other Title I, Part A statutory and regulatory obligations, (to the extent they are not waived) including the obligations in sections 1114 and 1115 to have schoolwide and targeted assistance programs that "use effective methods and instructional strategies that are based on scientifically based research".

**5. Waiver to Allow LEAs to Offer SES, in Addition to Public School Choice, to Eligible Students in Title I Schools in The First Year of School Improvement**

We are requesting a waiver for school year 2009-10 to provide SES to students in year 1 of school improvement (a year earlier than the law normally requires) and count the costs of those services towards our 20% obligation.
